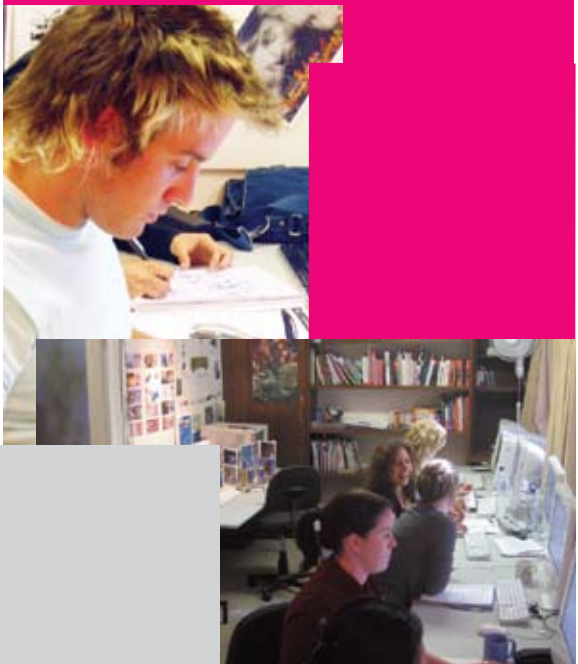


SUMMER COURSES JAN/FEB 2010



DRAWING AND PAINTING STUDIO

An intensive summer studio program teaching skills and a variety of approaches in drawing and painting. The course suits those with no experience and will involve life drawing, general drawing, painting methods and techniques, and more adventurous and individually developed approaches to art making. This course is particularly recommended for:

1. Individuals wishing to develop or add to folio preparation for entry to university degree programs in art and design.
2. those wanting a great introduction to the courses and Single Subjects here at Latrobe College in the fine art and art & design Certificate through to Diploma courses.

During the Summer Course students will work with up to three of the well known teachers from this school. It will enable them to gain invaluable insight into the different subjects that these teachers specialise in and to also gauge what other courses or creative directions might interest them.

Photoshop, Illustrator Indesign, Dreamweaver, Flash

These CS3 Adobe programs are the established industry imaging, graphics, layout and web software essential not just to graphic designers, photographers, publishing houses and web designers but to almost all small to medium businesses and offices that use some form of in house image or graphics for their business or promotional material. In this course people will be introduced to and gain a hands-on understanding of the fundamentals of these programs enabling them to create a vairyety of material relevent to their interests. ENROLMENT & PAYMENT CONDITIONS

Applying / Enrolling Please telephone the college to determine available course places! Then fill in and return this form with payment, instalment or deposit to confirm your application / enrolment to LaTrobe College (address next panel).

Deposits A place can be reserved with a deposit, which is deducted from the course fee. If you are paying a deposit the balance of the course fee or initial Instalment Payment is strictly payable before the first class. See next panel for instalment amounts

Instalment Payment Option An initial payment followed by a set number of monthly Instalments, strictly payable on the first of each month - see amounts in course information booklet (Single Subjects arrangements will be different). Late payments incur a 5% fee. Any payments over a month late will incur 10% fee.

Refunds and Conditions Upon enrolment you will be liable for the full cost of the course notwithstanding that you may choose not to complete the course. If students are unable to complete their course credit may be given towards another. Withdrawal in writing prior to 10 working days before the first class, any payment less the deposit will be refunded. In the event of a student withdrawing from a course 10 working days or less from the date classes commence all fees are forfeited, or credit can be given towards another course. Consideration will be given to alter the foregoing in extreme circumstances. Courses are subject to numbers.
