EXPLORE THE BIENNALE WITH A PERMANENT PASS, VISIT MUSEUMS AND GALLERIES, PRODUCE AN ART JOURNAL, ATTEND PRACTICAL CLASSES, WORK ON PROJECTS, EXPLORE VENICE AND OUTLYING ISLANDS THEN RETURN TO MELBOURNE AND PARTICIPATE IN A JOURNAL EXHIBITION AT LATROBE COLLEGE GALLERY. THE TRIP IS ACCREDITED AS A DRAWING SUBJECT IN THE DIPLOMA OF VISUAL ART AND IS OPEN TO STUDENTS AND PEOPLE OUTSIDE THE COLLEGE.

NO PREVIOUS ART EXPERIENCE IS NECESSARY. WE WELCOME BOTH BEGINNERS AND THE MORE ADVANCED. TWO FULL TIME LECTURERS ACCOMPANYING THE GROUP.
